How do I share my medical information	Complete a data sharing consent form available from the surgery or download from Ashville Medical Practice Website	You will be required to share your medical information on the clinical system (Systm One) at the GP surgery first. Once shared the organisations above will be able to view some of your medical information (as listed above) with your permission, when you make contact with the service	Every-one has a summary care record unless you have chosen to opt out. You can choose to opt out of the scheme by completing a form and bringing it to the surgery. The form can also be obtained from the surgery	The National Data Opt Out is a programme of work led by NHS Digital.
